Job Description

1. To develop, supervise and manage all areas of the cricket development programme across all age groups and both genders within the Cayman Islands.
2. To create and monitor specific programmes to be followed by all coaches.
3. To develop and manage coaching education and development programmes.
4. To oversee the implementation of Cayman Cricket's strategic development plan and ensure that the target Key Performance Indicators (KPI) set within the plan are achieved.
5. To deliver coaching at various levels of the cricket programme as required.

Requirements

The ideal candidate will have –

- (a) Internationally recognised certification as a cricket coach/coaching education instructor;
- (b) At least five (5) years' experience in senior high performance coaching ;
- (c) Proven familiarity with modern coaching techniques suitable for all formats of cricket;
- (d) A proven track record in the development and delivery of cricket programs from grass roots levels through the pathway to high performance;
- (e) Knowledge of elite player development systems, and how they differ and integrate with community sport programmes;
- (f) Strong interpersonal and communications skills with the ability to convey technical planning to non-technical stakeholders, including parents of players;
- (g) The ability to motivate and work with key stakeholders of Cayman Cricket;

- (h) Ability to think and plan strategically, and effectively link technical planning with broader goals and strategic intent;
- (i) Strong background in the use of data and video analysis and information technology in delivering cricket coaching and player management;
- (j) Current and valid certification in C.P.R. and/or First Aid.
